Following the implementation of WIOA, the initial and subsequent eligibility process has been amended. Going forward, initial eligibility will be for a period of one year; continuing eligibility will be the determination of a provider's eligibility to continue receiving funds after a period of initial eligibility. The period of continued eligibility will be for a maximum of two years for each program (youth, adult and displaced). Training programs that are currently in subsequent eligibility (under WIOA) must apply for continued eligibility. Programs that have never been on the state list will be eligible for initial eligibility. Providers interested in being on the State List must apply through the ETPL module in the Participant Record Information System (PRIS). New providers who do not have a password to access the module should request a password at the following email address: prisddec@ddec.pr.gov.
