PUBLIC POLICY FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
IN THE EVENT OF ATMOSPHERIC PHENOMENA

Section 1. The Southwest Local Workforce Development Board, Inc. based on Public Law 113-128, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), to create Public Policy for emergency management in the event of a severe weather event.

Section 2. The Local Board for these purposes establishes the following:

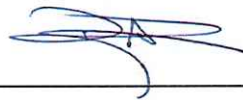
That during an emergency due to unforeseen causes such as: storms, hurricanes, floods, earthquakes and others, the Local Board and the Board of Mayors of the ALDLS, through their Presidents, shall take the corresponding action in the handling of these events, taking into consideration the recommendations of the National Weather Service, the guidelines stipulated by the State through press releases, radio, television, as well as any Executive Order that may arise while the emergency is in effect due to these natural phenomena.

Section 3. In the event of an emergency, personnel are authorized to return home to prepare for the weather phenomenon.

Section 4ta. This Public Policy will be in effect for the duration of the Emergency.

Section 5ta. This Public Policy shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Local Board.
